This range of products is used in a process that relies on traditional technologies, such as immersion, since it adapts to the specific properties of each type of stone. Moreover, the Harder Rock range is compatible with the Soundstone® patented technology by Pedrini, which means that it can be used for vacuum impregnation as it binds chemically with the material, thus further improving its resistance.

This technology makes materials resistant to erosion, water-repellent and protected against contaminants, while preserving the stone's original appearance and slipperiness. It is also sustainable, solvent-free and designed for withstanding external agents and UV rays without impacting its properties.
